From major investment in community spaces, to funding much-needed equipment and activities, to responding to the cost-of-living crisis, we are proud of the work we do to empower small groups to overcome challenges and meet the needs of their own community.



2024 Recap



Throughout the year, Asda Foundation gave 2,603 grants totaling £3,229,392 of funding to enable community groups to address the issues that mattered most.

Grants were used for a wide range of activities – from keeping the lights on in community centres at risk of closing, to refurbishing outdoor spaces, to bringing people together to combat isolation and loneliness.







Outdoor Community Spaces Fund



Supporting grassroots community groups to improve safe and accessible outdoor spaces across the UK.



Young Peoples Fund



Supporting grassroots groups to improve mental health and wellbeing for teens and young people (13-21 years) to help build better futures.
