HEALTH & WELLBEING CHALLENGE FUND 2016 TO 2022 CASE STUDIES

ST AUSTELL LEISURE

£65,000 investment in Sept 2019 & Dec

2022

- St Austell Leisure runs the Tregorrick Leisure Centre, a community-focused leisure centre that aims to increase local participation in sport and active leisure.
- Initial investment was to refurbish the gym, expand their offering, and cover upfront revenue costs.
- Further investment in Dec 2022 was to construct a new hall so that they can increase their booking numbers.
- Impact to date:
 - weekly attendance figures of 1500 between Apr 2021 & Mar 2022.
 - growing membership numbers, increased community provision and improved health outcomes.





KARREK COMMUNITY

- Karrek Community provides a high-quality care service for adults with learning disabilities. They provide person-centered support to enable vulnerable people to remain living in their own home for as long as is possible.
- Our investment helped Karrek to build capacity by recruiting and training staff, employing new technologies and raising awareness of their services.
- Impact so far:
 - Established hubs within communities from which the services are run, reducing travel time for carers and ensuring services stay local.
 - Delivered 1500 hours of direct support each week between Apr 21 and Mar 22.

£195,000 investment in June 2017 & July 2018







MEMORY MATTERS

£60,000 investment in Mar 2018 & Nov 2018

- Memory Matters runs the Moments Café in the heart of Plymouth.
- It works to change the face of dementia support in the community using therapeutic approaches to memory loss for those living with dementia and their carers alike.
- Our investment supported the development and implementation of a model to allow them to package their current offer so it can be rolled out across the region.
- Impact so far:
 - Between Apr 2021 & Mar 2022 they supported 40,000 beneficiaries through their café, information hub, events and Cognitive Stimulation Therapy (CST) workshops.
 - They ensure that those affected by dementia feel visible, valued and heard and continue to thrive and contribute to their communities.
