6 Step Project Management

1. Idea and Vision

What is the issue we are trying to address?

- Who are our beneficiaries?
- What do our beneficiaries have to say about our idea?
- What will our project achieve in the broadest terms?

2. Objectives and Outcomes

Requirements of the project

- Map out the story of the project and its users
- Identify the deliverables required for the project
- Examine any 'pain points' that might affect your project

3. The Project Plan

What will the project look like

- Map tasks against timescales
- Assign workstreams and tasks within team
- Define budget and funding requirements

4. Funding

Successfully funding the project

- Identify funding sources
- Set funding targets and timelines
- Seek advice from Transformation Cornwall/Diocese if necessary

5. Execution

Rolling out the project

- Consider a small scale rollout of your service at first
- Keep communicating with your users and community
- Repeat this cycle for any alterations to the project

6. Follow-Up

Evaluating your project

- Is the project delivering on its vision?
- Are we within budget?
- How can it be further improved?
