WHAT YOUR CHURCH NEEDS TO DO

- Pass a PCC resolution to adopt a ‘Parish Creation Care Policy’ to include the following;
 - Creation Care as a permanent PCC agenda item.
 - Annual carbon footprint return as part of annual parish returns.
 - Creation Sunday service or Creation-tide service / event.
- For each parish, appoint a Creation Care Champion / Officer (or team of Champions) who are supported by and report to the PCC.
- Register with the A Rocha Eco Church scheme.
- Carry out the initial environmental audit via the Eco Church scheme.
