Hope at Home is a UK-wide hosting scheme for survivors of modern slavery and human trafficking. We train and support hosts to welcome a survivor into their homes for an agreed period of time. We offer hosts:

- ✔ In-depth training
- ✔ Safeguarding procedures
- ✔ Thorough matching process
- ✔ Ongoing support



## Who can host?

Our hosts are a mixture of employed, unemployed, retired, families with small children, families with teenagers, singles, couples, people with faith and people with none.

Their most important attributes are flexibility, sense of humour, openness to learning new things and being welcoming.

## Types of guests

- Male and female
- Adults
- Pregnant women
- Mums and small children
- Asylum seekers
- Refugees waiting for housing
- EU citizens looking for work.

3 We'll help you to complete your application form.

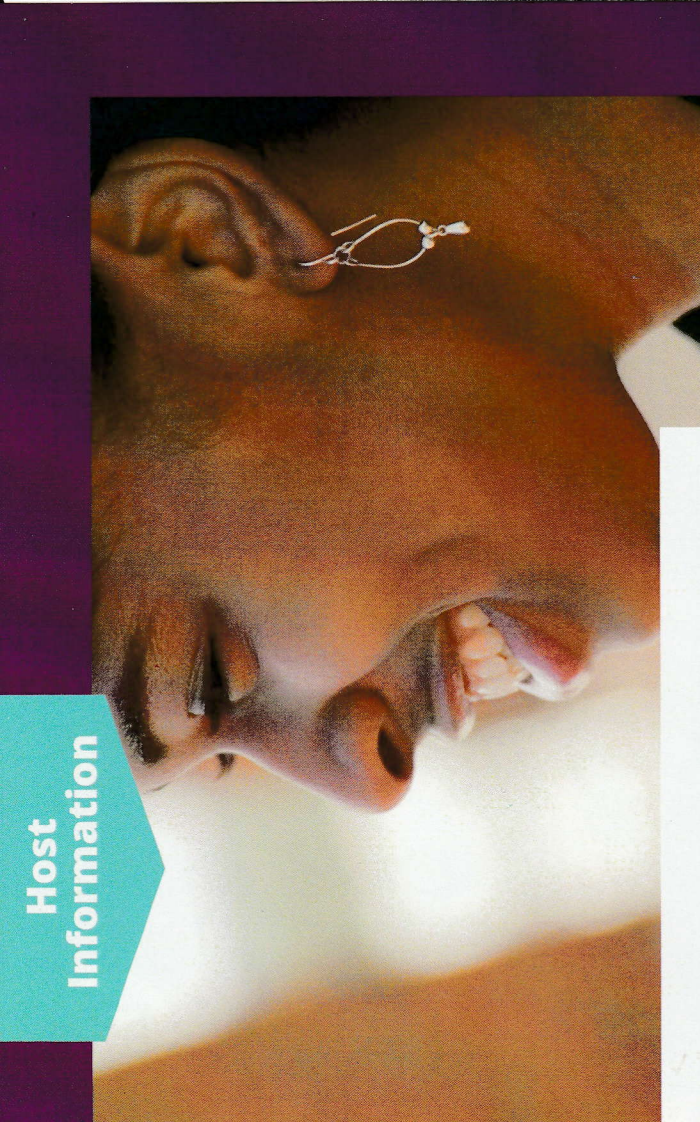
4 We'll arrange a home visit before matching you with your guest.
