Grant Funding

The Morrisons Foundation funds charities running projects that make a positive difference in local communities.

- Operates in England, Scotland and Wales
- Applicants must be registered charities
- Up to £25k for up to 1 year
- Fully fund projects
- No deadline - apply when suits you!





Match Funding

Morrisons employs around 100,000 people. They and their immediate family members can boost their fundraising by up to £5,000 through our Match Funding programme.

If you know someone that works for Morrisons, or one of their immediate relatives, they could fundraise for your charity!

- Unsolicited and unrestricted
 - Must be to a charity
- Only colleagues can claim





Community Champions

Every one of our Morrisons stores and sites has a dedicated Community Champion who plays a crucial role in connecting our stores with their surrounding communities.

Community Champions can:

- connect you with other organisations in your area
- provide tangible items for your events or projects
- supporting your application to Morrisons Foundation and provide a direct route in to our team
