You can be sure that Thrive Together Birmingham will do all it can to ensure your rights in relation to your personal data are upheld. As a result, all our staff and volunteers that have access to any of your information (as agreed by the Data Protection Officer) are regularly trained in the handling of your data. We also review our policy every two years.

We will never sell, rent, or trade your personal data. We do not share your data with any other third parties other than expressly shared above. We also may disclose your information if required by law or to enforce our legal rights.

Some of our service providers and affiliated organisations lie outside the EU. Therefore, sometimes we transfer your data outside the EU. If we do, we ensure your data is processed only in countries that provide an adequate level of protection for your data or where the recipient provides appropriate safeguards, such as model contract clauses, binding corporate rules, or mechanisms like the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield framework.
